Qualifications for Nominee:

1. Candidates must have a minimum of 10 years in Knights of Columbus and Council # 6398.
2. Candidate must be a Knight in good standing.
3. Candidate has consistently demonstrated the three principles of the order to his brother Knights and to the parish community: charity, unity and fraternity.
4. Candidate has demonstrated leadership and active participation within the council and the parish community at large.
5. Candidate demonstrates consideration for the spiritual well being of himself and others through his thought, word and deeds.

Procedures for Submitting Nominations:

- A. During the month of September and October, the Nominating Committee will accept nominations from any member of the council.
- B. To Nominate a Candidate, submit on paper or via e-mail a single paragraph describing why your nominee would be a good candidate for this award. All written nominations should be given to Mark Morgan, Mark Murray or Craig Vrabel by November 4, 2010.

- C. After reading all nominations, the Nominating Committee will nominate the recipient and give it to the Grand Knight for approval.

Nominations close on November 4, 2010 after the Officer Meeting.

Presentation of awards will be at a reception or dinner after the Memorial Mass in November along with other awards, such as Twenty Five Year Member Pins, Honorary Life Member Pins, and Past Grand Knight Pins.
